LEGAL ASPECTS OF BUSINESS

COURSE DESCRIPTION

MGT 2106 introduces students to business-related aspects of the American legal system. Students will be exposed to a variety of areas including constitutional law, administrative law, dispute resolution, business formation and equal employment opportunity as well as contracts, torts and property. The course also focuses on enhancing student awareness of ethical issues. The emphases of the course are issue recognition, the resolution of such issues through application of legal principles and determination of the consistency of such principles with ethical considerations.

PREREQUISITE
