INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS LAW

COURSE DESCRIPTION

MGT 4803 is designed to introduce students to the legal environment of international trade and private commercial transactions. Specific areas of study will include the legal environment of international trade and business, the regulation of U.S. trade, the GATT, import and export regulation, customs law, regional trade agreements, international contracting, intellectual property rights protections and licensing, and the sale of services. The emphases of the course are recognition of legal problems and the discovery and application of appropriate principles of international and domestic law that may assist in resolving these problems.

COURSE PREREQUISITE

Students enrolled in MGT 4803 are required to have completed MGT 2106 or its equivalent with a passing grade.
